Catbacker Baseball Day

On April 23rd, 2011 on Frank Myers Field at Tointon Family Stadium the Topeka Area Catbackers enjoyed an afternoon of K-State baseball as the Wildcats defeated the Red Raiders 4-1 and completed their first ever series sweep over the visitors. Prior to the game, a prize drawing was held and several Catbacker members received gifts on behalf of the club. Notably, Craig Selly, the coordinator of the event won a K-State baseball cap, and jokingly, Craig promised all other members that his name being drawn was completely by coincidence.

During the action, Jason King tallied a career-high four hits, including his second triple of the series in the seventh inning. He drove in a pair of runs with singles in the first and again in the third, when he plated Martini who led the frame off with a double.

A sweep of the series with Texas Tech marked 3 victories towards the Cat's final 36-23 record, which was good enough to raise the Wildcats to its third-straight NCAA Regional bid Monday as they were slotted as the No. 3 seed in the Fullerton Regional, hosted by Cal State Fullerton, at Goodwin Field. With the regional bid, Kansas State became one of six schools nationally that had its football team reach a bowl game, and have both basketball programs and its baseball team all reach the NCAA Tournament.

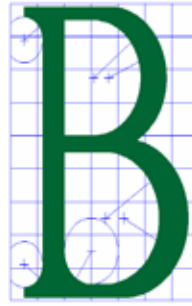
